He has played saxophone for thirty five years and still loves it. His broad-based career has encompassed TV production, comedy writing, public speaking, 16 years of Hey Hey it's Saturday, radio and the theatre, having acted and sung in "Hey Hey it's Cinderella" and "The New Rocky Horror Show", with which he toured internationally after completing sold-out seasons in all states of Australia.
