Bryan won the George Piggins Medal in 2003 as South Sydney's best and fairest player of the season.

Now a media star Bryan "Fletch" Fletcher is regarded one of the most gifted television stars in sport. Best known for his role on Fox Sports' Monday Night Live Show, Fletch has won thousands of fans with his dry sense of humour.
