

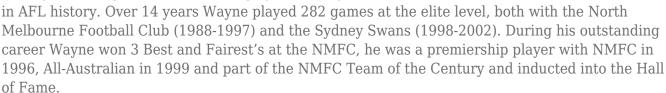
Wayne Schwass

From here, Wayne went from strength to strength, quickly becoming one of the most highly-rated players

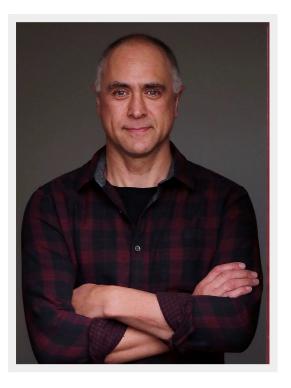


Since retiring in 2002, Wayne has established himself as a highly respected AFL broadcaster on TV, radio, print and online. However, in addition to his work within the sporting world, Wayne has also become a passionate and leading advocate for mental health awareness.

In 2017 Wayne founded PukaUp a social enterprise focusing on mental health, emotional wellbeing and, importantly, suicide prevention. According to Wayne, the PukaUp vision is to 'create the environments for every person to have authentic and genuine conversations about mental health and emotional wellbeing'.

As well as running PukaUp, Wayne also delivers powerful and honest keynote speeches at countless mental health seminars and workshops, where his message never fails to resonate with audiences.

In 2019 saw Wayne finish up as part of the Triple M AFL commentary Team and as host of 'Off the Bench TV". Wayne is focusing up on eliminating the stigma of Men's Mental Health and focusing on his organization PukaUp.
