Benjamin Law is a Sydney-based journalist, *Good Weekend* columnist and TV screenwriter. He's the author of two books – the black comedy memoir *The Family Law* (2010) and the travelogue *Gaysia: Adventures in the Queer East* (2012). Both books were nominated for Australian Book Industry Awards, and *The Family Law* is now a major TV series on SBS, with the third and final season now streaming.



Benjamin also has a PhD in creative writing from QUT, has taught writing to both adults and children, and is a regular speaker on radio, TV and at writers' festivals across the country.

Benjamin has written for over 50 publications in Australia and beyond-including *The Monthly*, *frankie*, *Good Weekend*, the *Guardian*, *The Australian*, *Monocle* and the *Australian Financial Review*.

The Family Law is now also an award-winning TV series for SBS, which Benjamin created and co-writes. Benjamin was also a researcher and associate producer on *Blackfella Films' Deep Water: The Real Story* (SBS) and a writer on Endemol *Shine's Sisters* (Ten).

You can hear him co-hosting ABC RN's weekly pop culture show *Stop Everything*, and watch him as a panellist on TV shows like ABC's *Screen Time*, *Q&A* and *The Drum*.

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
